## NOTIFICATION

### Subject:- List of Agencies to implement e-GP

This is to notify the following Agencies (*List Attached*) that the Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system training had been completed to all the stakeholders to use the e-GP system now. For effective implementation of the e-GP system, the following directives are to be complied with:

1. All Procuring Agencies (PA) *must register in the e-GP system* for which the Agencies must provide the details of one dedicated Procuring Agency (PA) Administrator.
2. All interested Bidders (Contractors, Suppliers and Consultants) have to register in the e-GP system to avail all government procurement opportunities through email and SMS.
3. Conduct of procurement through the e-GP system shall be guided by e-GP Guidelines, which is available under e-Learning on the e-GP website [www.e-gp.gov.bt](http://www.e-gp.gov.bt)
4. For PAs which do not have dedicated procurement officer(s) are to nominate a focal person as PA User and submit to GPPMD for creating required credentials.
5. The Financial Institutions shall facilitate the financial transactions related to e-GP using the prescribed format as per the Standard Bidding Document (SBD).

This Notification is issued for strict compliance and shall come into force from November 1, 2019 in addition to already existing agencies.
